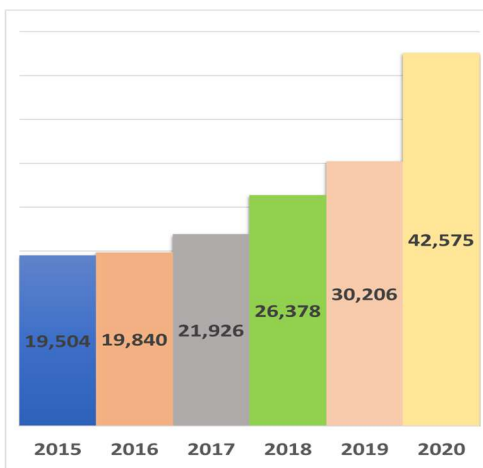
### YOUR GENEROSITY KEEPS US GOING, GROWING & SERVING...
